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ARED is a n NGO 501(c)3, founded in 1990, that works to improve foundational literacy and mathematics through educational innovations, bilingual education (African languages/French) and publishing.

ARED is based in Dakar, Senegal with programs and networks across the Sahel.

ARED has a highly qualified team of educational, training, linguistic and publishing experts.

ARED has vast experience in the fields of teaching, publishing and training.

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ARED created the Senegal's "Bilingualism in Real Time" program and the accelerated remediation program *Ndaw Wune (Success for All)*. The latter provides accelerated learning in reading and mathematics to struggling students (often more than 70% of the students in a class). There is almost unlimited need for this type of program in francophone Africa.

ARED has published more than 300 titles in over 1.5 million copies in six Senegalese languages: Pulaar, Wolof, Mandinka, Seereer, Sooninké and Joola and in French.

ARED is the lead Senegalese technical partner for USAID Senegal'programs to improve reading achievement in the early grades at scale: *Reading For All (Chemonics)* and RELIS (RTI). ARED is also the lead African partner for USDA's School Achievement Improvement projects in Senegal and Mauritania.

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ARED has been funded by the Hewlett Foundation, Dubai Cares, USAID (through Chemonics and RTI), USDA, the Echidna Foundation and others.

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ARED's assistance in improving educational outcomes is frequently requested by many Senegalese and African organizations and governments (Mali, Niger, Burkina Faso, Benin, Guinea, Chad, Mauritania, Togo ...)
